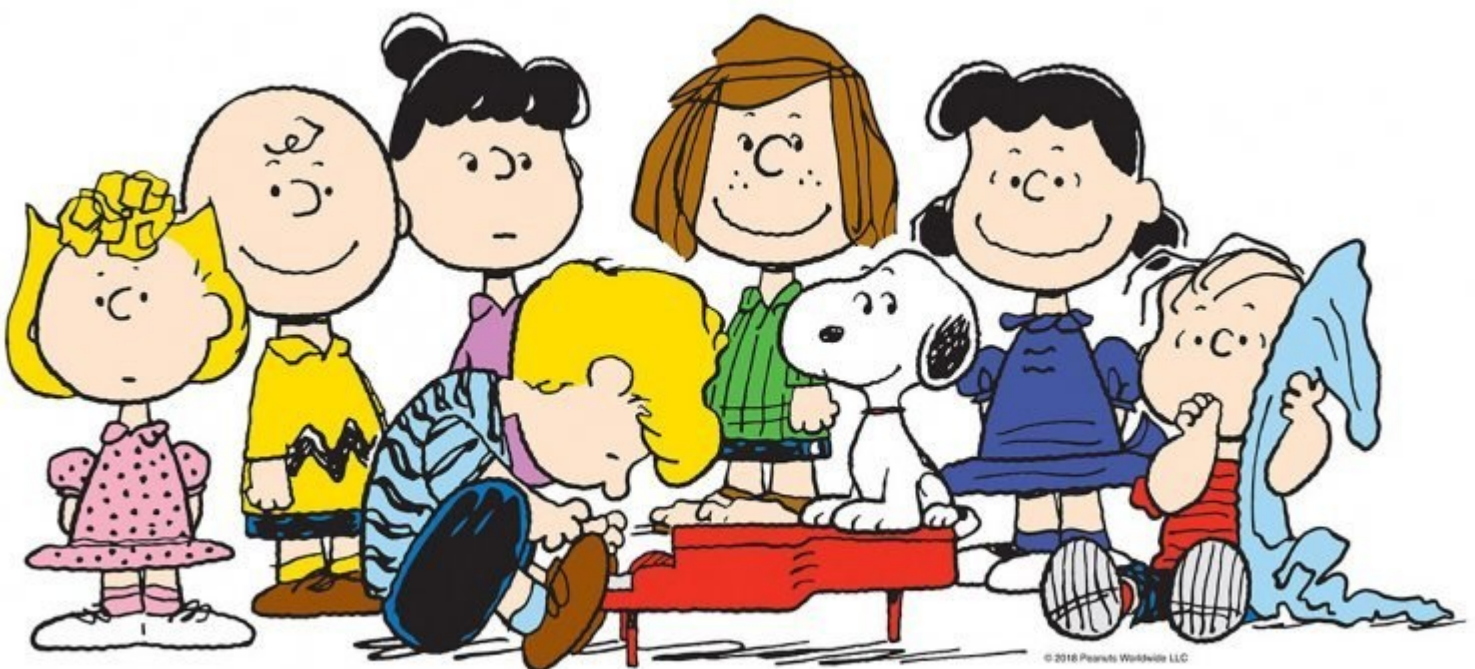
Tuff eNUFF Challenge
